- Definition





Etiology:

- Primary (50%)
- Secondary (50%)
 - A- Prenatal
 - **B- Natal**
 - **C- Postnatal**

Varieties:

- 1- Spastic CP (70%):
 - A- Spastic Hemiplegia (25-40%).
 - B- Spastic Diplegia (25-35%)
 - C- Spastic Quadriplegia (40-45%)
- 2- Dystonic (Athetoid) CP (10-15%)
- 3- Ataxic CP (5%)
- 4- Mixed CP (10%)





Diagnosis:

- * Often clinical
- * Sometimes CT scan, MRI

Cerebral Palsy Treatment

Some of the most common treatment options for children with cerebral palsy include:

- + Physical Therapy
- + Surgery
- **+** Medications
- + Stem Cell Injections
- + Alternative Therapies
