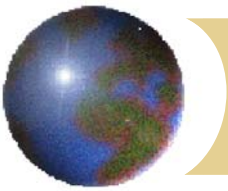
Elective sessions

- ❖ Omission of two activities.



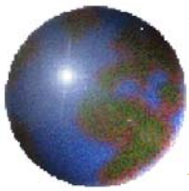
Primary Health Care (PHC)
